FIRST SACRAMENTS AT SACRED HEART



This is the year your child will be able to receive their First Sacraments. Immediate preparation for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist generally occurs for children in grade 2 (or older) who have been baptized. In order to begin preparation to receive these Sacraments please **RSVP by registering for** Faith Formation on our parish website. What a blessing it is to be part of preparing your child to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist (First Communion) for the first time! This will be an exceptional and challenging year and as we begin there are a number of things you will need to know. Please be sure to contact us if you have any questions or concerns.

The expectations for those preparing for these sacraments are:

- Parent or guardian attend one of the Parent First Sacrament Meetings.
- attendance at a Catholic school. Remember, we are all lifelong learners!
- Retreats and one of the First Communion Retreat/Rehearsals.
- we require your child's certificate you will be notified by mail.

Secret Prayer Partners—Shhh! It's a surprise!

You may choose someone to serve as a secret prayer partner for your child. This person will pray for them throughout the year and perhaps send them notes or letters of encouragement as your child prepares for the Sacraments. The Secret Prayer Partners will wait until the day of your child's First Communion to reveal their identity. Great choices for this are grandparents, aunts, uncles, or godparents. Please return the enclosed sheet with the mailing information for your child and their prayer partner to Jen Haman in the Parish Office by December 1, 2021. We will then send a letter of explanation to their prayer partner.

• **Note:** You will be asked to sign up for the First Reconciliation Retreat and the First Eucharist Retreat/Rehearsal as well as the date your child will celebrate First Eucharist at the Parent Meeting.

Reconciliation Retreat: Sign up for either Saturday, January 8 or Saturday, January 16, 9:00 – 11:30am in the Parish Hall and the Worship Space. This retreat includes celebration of First Reconciliation and the child must be accompanied by a parent. If something comes up and you are unable to attend the reIt is recommended that those celebrating First Communion plan to celebrate the sacrament of Reconciliation a second time prior to receiving First Communion. There are many opportunities to do that at Sacred Heart or at the other Catholic Churches in the area. Saint Katharine Drexel school children usually celebrate Reconciliation in Lent during the school day. See our parish bulletin for additional dates and times.

- First Communion Retreat: Saturday, April 23, 9-11:30am; Sunday, April 24, 1-3:30pm; Monday, April 25, \diamond 6-8:30pm; or Tuesday, April 26, 6-8:30pm in the Parish Hall and the Worship Space. At least one parent must attend with their child. Tasting of the bread and the wine will be part of the retreat.

Special Needs: If your child or a family member has special needs in regard to the retreats, rehearsals, or celebrations of the Sacraments, contact Jen. Please let us know if your child has a gluten intolerance or other concern.

What to Wear for First Communion: Children should wear something "dressy," as they would for a special occasion. Girls can wear either white or colored dresses – veils are optional. The St. Cloud Book Shop has donated some First Communion dresses. If you are interested in looking at them, contact Jen. Boys should have dress pants with a nice shirt – white or colored, ties are optional. No jeans or t-shirts, please. This should be a special occasion for the children but not cause a financial hardship for anyone.

Photographs: We ask that you refrain from taking flash photographs during Mass as not to disrupt the prayerful spirit of the liturgy. You may take pictures in the church after Mass. Our priests are happy to pose for photos with your child after Mass. We will have the children pose as a group at the end of each Mass for a group photo.

Volunteers: If family members would like to be Ushers, Altar Servers, Eucharistic Ministers or Lectors at the Mass when your child is celebrating First Eucharist, contact Jen or Jill in the Parish Office by Wednesday, January 5.

Important points to remember about the Eucharist:

- Jesus is really present in His Body & Blood that we receive, in the form of the bread and the wine. •
- Preparing to receive Eucharist is preparation for a lifetime of communion with Jesus and each other. It is more than just this one day.
- We are called to live our faith by worshipping regularly with the faith community, by recognizing and ٠ growing in holiness in daily life, and by serving others.

FAITH FORMATION WELLNESS POLICY

At Sacred Heart Church, we strive to provide a healthy environment for all and ask those experiencing symptoms of communicable illnesses refrain from in-person activities. We will do our best to maintain a safe environment and follow all COVID guidelines and protocols set forth by the Diocese of St. Cloud, but with any gathering there is a risk.

Due to COVID, we can't emphasize enough the importance of following our wellness policy. If in the last 10 days, you or someone you are bringing, have been told to quarantine by a medical or government official, had a fever, or a persistent dry cough or shortness of breath, we ask that you please stay home. We appreciate your care and consideration for others.

Participants should screen themselves and/or their children before attending Faith Formation. If you or one of your children are experiencing any of the below symptoms of communicable illnesses, we ask that you to please keep them at home.

- Fever (100.4°F or higher) or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Green nasal discharge
- Unexplainable rash
- Watery, matted eyes
